2 MR. CHAIRMAN: We will call the meeting  
3 to order. Are there any comments on the  
4 minutes?

5 MR. MACHTAY: I gave my comments to  
6 Christine and with those changes, I will  
7 move them.

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: Very good. Is there a  
9 second?

10 MR. RUSSO: I second.

11 MR. CHAIRPERSON: Discussion?

12 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

13 MR. CHAIRMAN: All in favor?

14 THE COUNCIL: Aye.

15 MR. CHAIRMAN: Opposed?

16 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: Motion carries.

18 Jim, is there <sup>Correspondence</sup> ~~correspondents~~ that you  
19 want to make us aware of?

20 MR. BAGG: No.

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: Nobody writes to us  
22 anymore.

23 All right and Historic Trust, do you  
24 want to wait for Rich?

25 MS. SPENCER: Yes, please.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: You might end up at the  
3 bottom of the menu again.

4 MS. SPENCER: I actually don't think  
5 there is anything to report. He can amend  
6 that.

7 MR. CHAIRMAN: Jim gets upset with us  
8 when we go out of order. We don't want to  
9 upset you, Jim.

10 MS. SPENCER: On the Historic Trust  
11 Docket Directed Report, I believe there are  
12 no updates.

13 MR. BAGG: If I might clarify that. We  
14 type up the resolutions in order. If  
15 something doesn't take a resolution by the  
16 Council, then technically it doesn't upset  
17 the order. The Historic Trust is  
18 information that is usually --

19 MS. SPENCER: Usually.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay --

21 MR. MACHTAY: Does somebody have an  
22 extra agenda because I don't seem to have  
23 one?

24 MR. CHAIRMAN: Recommended Type Two  
25 Actions Proposed Storm Drain Pollution on

2 various county roads -- CP 8239 Phase III,  
3 Towns of Babylon, Islip, and East Hampton.  
4 This is a big package.

5 MR. BAGG: You missed a page on  
6 ratifications.

7 MR. CHAIRMAN: I did? Sorry about  
8 that.

9 Ratification -- we will go back to  
10 Ratification of Recommendations for  
11 Legislative Resolutions. Anything to note?

12 MR. BAGG: It is fairly straight  
13 forward. Everything is Type Two Actions.  
14 SEQRA has been previously completed on the  
15 projects.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: I notice Resolution  
17 1031, one of our members is seeking  
18 reappointment.

19 MR. KAUFMAN: I think that should be a  
20 positive declaration. I will defer to Jim  
21 on that.

22 MR. CHAIRPERSON: Does everybody here  
23 know what their reappointment dates are so  
24 they can work on them?

25 THE COUNCIL: No.

MR. CHAIRMAN: I would inquire from Jim because while you stay a member until you get kicked off, it is important to keep the process rolling. I think that is the way it is supposed to be.

MR. MACHTAY: Five year appointment?

MR. CHAIRMAN: It depends on whether you replace somebody -- that kind of thing. If you're a new appointment because somebody had retired and there was three years left on the term, your appointment would have been for three years. So, Jim, maybe next month --

MR. BAGG: We will e-mail the CEQ list, and next to each individuals name is your reappointment date. Michael is the only individual who is up for reappointment this year. I think next year there is two or three reappointments.

MR. KAUFMAN: Just to let everyone know, it is generally about a three month process to get your legislator to sponsor you or whoever its been. You have to, generally, go the legislature to do all of

1 this and there is committee meetings. For  
2 example, I have one on the 23rd where I have  
3 to show up before a EPA which is led by  
4 Legislator Schneiderman. You have to get  
5 your resume typed up and submitted again.  
6 They generally have it, but they like to  
7 have an updated one. Because of the  
8 procedures over there, they have to lay it  
9 on the table -- there could be a month gap  
10 or something like that. They don't always  
11 get to it. So when it happens, I would,  
12 generally, try to look at it about three  
13 months before.  
14

15 MR. CHAIRMAN: Anything else?

16 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: Jim, you want to call  
18 your attention?

19 MR. BAGG: No.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: The other one that I  
21 inadvertently skipped was the Proposed  
22 Purchase of Replacement Equipment at  
23 established --

24 MR. BAGG: There is a motion on the --

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Motion to approve

2 Legislative Recommendations that were layed  
3 on the table.

4 MS. SPENCER: So moved.

5 MR. MACHTAY: Second.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: All in favor?

7 THE COUNCIL: Aye.

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: Opposed?

9 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: Motion carries.

11 (WHEREUPON, the Board voted.)

12 MR. CHAIRMAN: Proposed Purchase of  
13 Replacement Equipment at established tower  
14 sites. This is Capital Project 3017. It is  
15 a GPS system.

16 MR. MACHTAY: Type II Action?

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: It is a Recommended Type  
18 II Action.

19 MR. MACHTAY: I will make a motion.

20 MR. BAGG: We have a police officer  
21 here.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Since he made the  
23 trouble to come, we may as well give him a  
24 few minutes. Would you care to comment on  
25 the project?

2 MR. FISHER: Well, the item itself is a  
3 replacement item --

4 MR. CHAIRMAN: Sir, if you could stand  
5 up and give us your name -- boy, this fun --  
6 telling a policeman what to do.

7 (WHEREUPON, there was laughter.)

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: Welcome to CEQ.

9 MR. FISHER: It is my pleasure to be  
10 here.

11 MR. CHAIRMAN: So, if you a could just  
12 tell us a little bit about the proposed  
13 program or replaced equipment. As I  
14 understand it, it is about a decade or more  
15 old?

16 MR. FISHER: Yes, that is correct.  
17 First I would like to give my name. My name  
18 is Mark Fisher. I am Lieutenant for the  
19 Suffolk County Police Department, and I am  
20 working in the Bureau Records --  
21 Communication and Records Bureau.

22 Yes, the equipment is approximately  
23 ten years old. It is electronic equipment.  
24 If we need any specifics on it, I have -- I  
25 refer to him as the brains of the operation,

2 Andy, one of our technicians. From a layman  
3 point of view, it is a ten year old  
4 electronic equipment. If we can think of  
5 our computer systems in our house, they  
6 don't last that long. This is 24/7 stuff.  
7 It is communications and it directly effects  
8 communications.

9 We have problems now with getting parts  
10 for it, if it does break. Things are made  
11 modular. It isn't like the old days when  
12 some of us might remember when you went to  
13 the pharmacy and checked the tubes on the  
14 television set. Right now, everything is  
15 pretty much replacement components, and it  
16 is very expensive.

17 Our concern -- our major concern is if  
18 this apparatus fails and depending on how it  
19 fails, it could be catastrophic to the  
20 County. It could take down an entire  
21 communication system. At best, it would  
22 take down a partial system and having  
23 partial communications could be devastating  
24 depending on what was happening at the  
25 particular time. So we don't want to chance

2 it. As you said, it is over ten years old  
3 and it is -- it is at the end of its life.

4 MR. CHAIRMAN: You want to say anything  
5 about the technical issues?

6 MR. MACHTAY: No.

7 MR. FISHER: I will say one thing. It  
8 is a replacement item so, I believe, there  
9 is no affect or impact on the environment.  
10 It is a -- I guess, taking out the unit and  
11 sliding the unit in to be simplified.

12 MR. CHAIRMAN: So, is the area of  
13 coverage or the detail of coverage going to  
14 be improved by the new equipment?

15 MR. MIKELINICH: That does not affect  
16 that. Like he said, it is direct  
17 replacement for equipment that is likely  
18 aging, and it will perform the same function  
19 as the replacement.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay, very good.

21 THE REPORTER: State your name, please.

22 MR. MIKELINICH: My name is Andrew  
23 Mikelinich, M-I-K-E-L-I-N-I-C-H.

24 MR. CHAIRMAN: Would you like to make a  
25 motion?

2 MR. MACHTAY: Type II Action.

3 MS. KAUFMAN: Second.

4 MR. CHAIRMAN: We have a motion and a  
5 second. It is a Type **II** Action.

6 Any further discussions?

7 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: All in favor?

9 THE COUNCIL: Aye.

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: Opposed?

11 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

12 MR. CHAIRMAN: Motion carries.

13 (WHEREUPON, the Council voted.)

14 MR. CHAIRMAN: Thank you for taking the  
15 time to come over and see us.

16 MR. FISHER: Thank you, sir, my  
17 pleasure.

18 MR. CHAIRMAN: Now, the one that I am  
19 so anxious to get to is the Proposed Storm  
20 Drain Pollution on various county roads --  
21 CP 8239, Phase III, Towns of Babylon, Islip,  
22 and East Hampton.

23 Anybody here to speak to that?

24 MR. BERGEY: I am, sir.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Please, identify

yourself for the Stenographer.

MR. BERGEY: My name is Eric Bergey. I am with the Department of Environment Energy and the Vision of Water Quality Improvement.

First, I would like to thank the Council for reviewing this tremendous package that we submitted a couple of weeks ago. I realize there is more paperwork than is normally submitted for one of our typical projects. This is not a typical project. It is 16 locations that are all currently directed discharges of untreated storm water into surface water body.

Our proposal is to redirect or actually make a minor modification in the existing drainage system, install a new treatment system, and I have several examples of typical treatment systems that we have been using recently which I am going to pass around. You can take a look at them.

We're not decided on which models are exactly going in which spot yet. That requires further design work. We're still in the initial stages. We selected

locations, obviously, and once we move forward through the DEC permitting process, then we will get to the point where we are selecting the actual models that will be used.

MR. CHAIRMAN: So will you be coming back to -- when you're actually doing the projects?

MR. BERGEY: I don't -- I am not sure. Maybe you can help me out with that. Do we need to come back or once there is that Type II --

MR. BAGG: I mean, we reviewed CR50. Basically, this is almost like the ~~insulation~~ <sup>installation</sup> of equipment at the end of the discharge area. Council said on CR50 that they thought it was a Type II Action because it wouldn't physically alter more than 4,000 square feet and involve the purchase of equipment at those particular sites. It does conform to the Council policy which, for many years, even before the storm water regulations and Council wanted to eliminate direct discharge to surface waters wherever

possible and the DPW has been trying to adhere to that and pursue that. In this particular instance, with respect to so many locations, I don't know if the entire project would be considered a Type II Action or on an individual basis probably Type II, but taken collectively might be considered an Unlisted Action with a Negative Declaration, but the equipment, if I understand, has to be approved by DEC and it has to be in conformance with the storm water regulation.

MR. BERGEY: Correct and the models that are being passed around are all currently on the DEC -- in the DEC Storm Water Manual as acceptable units, and that is something that we will be able to get a permit for.

MR. BAGG: And, also, it might be pointed out that before anything can be installed, the DPW has to get DEC permits for wetlands, as well as, the storm water discharge permits in conformance with the State.

1  
2 MR. BERGEY: Our next step in the  
3 process here is to actually meet with DEC  
4 because it is such a large project, and to  
5 go over all the locations with them and show  
6 them photos of all the locations. If not,  
7 meet them on-site, if they decide <sup>what</sup>~~that~~ is  
8 the best course of action and they will  
9 hopefully give us some guidance with the  
10 best way to move forward with the permit  
11 process and try to expedite it.

12 MR. MACHTAY: DEC hasn't issued any  
13 permits for this yet?

14 MR. BERGEY: Not this particular  
15 project, but they have permitted very  
16 similar projects.

17 MR. MACHTAY: I am concerned about this  
18 project.

19 MR. BERGEY: This project, no.

20 MR. KAUFMAN: A question for Jim. I  
21 agree given the way this is bubbled together  
22 takes it out of the general Type **II**. I  
23 would feel safer doing an Unlisted Negative  
24 Declaration on this, if that is what the  
25 Council agrees to. I don't see any

procedural difference. I think we have the information before us that we need. We have enough pictures, diagrams, and a good level of engineering understanding. So I would not feel uncomfortable doing it as an Unlisted. Is there any procedural impact if we did do it as Unlisted?

MR. BAGG: No. I mean, review the whole program and the installation of all the locations in terms of the environmental impact. Another thing that has to be considered is one of the requirements here that are part and parcel to the project is that, DPW has to get DEC permits. That is part of the process for the project.

MR. KAUFMAN: So we'll get a full review. I am not worried about that.

MR. BAGG: That's a given.

MR. MACHTAY: It appears that we have had projects bundled together. Jim, you told us that the Legislature wants separate resolutions on each project. Is that the case here?

MR. BAGG: No, I mean, in this

particular instance, this is one Capitol  
Program item; am I correct?

MR. BERGEY: Right.

MR. BAGG: So in essence, if they have  
separate Capitol Program items, they would  
like separate resolutions because the Bond  
Council reviews everything from a SEQRA  
point of view to make sure that SEQRA has  
been complied with, otherwise, you won't  
release any money which is probably why the  
County pays due diligence to making sure  
SEQRA is complied with but in this  
particular instance, because it is one  
Capitol Project, you could do the Negative  
Declaration for everything that has been  
presented to you.

MR. KAUFMAN: Also, Rich, just to let  
you know, some of the -- if my understanding  
is correct -- these projects were supposed  
to have been done last year in terms of  
doing the environmental analysis, et cetera  
and because it was the end of the year, some  
cracks opened up and these particular  
projects fell through. We're now getting it

1  
2 in a recast form as one cap project. So the  
3 County Legislature, from what I understand,  
4 wants to see this as a bundle so that is why  
5 it is in a single cap number, et cetera.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: One of my concerns is  
7 that, I think, I heard people from Suffolk  
8 County say that the existing vortex systems  
9 are not working up to expectations and yet  
10 this is what you're proposing to put in.

11 MR. BERGEY: These are individuals from  
12 DPW or from the general public?

13 MR. CHAIRMAN: No, from professional  
14 people in the County.

15 MR. BERGEY: Oh, okay.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: The sponge system --

17 MR. BAGG: The sponge --

18 MR. BERGEY: As long as those are  
19 maintained properly, they work beautifully.

20 MR. BAGG: I don't think it is vortex  
21 which is more or less a similar process.  
22 The County and the Suffolk County Water  
23 Authority had been installing the sponge  
24 filters in parking areas and everything  
25 else, and they accumulate a lot and the

1  
2 sponge gets clogged up with sediment and  
3 dirt and some pollutants, but most of it is  
4 probably sediment and dirt and that they're  
5 finding that they do not work as well and  
6 they require a large amount of maintenance.

7 The vortex system is not a sponge  
8 system and DPW has gone out and purchased  
9 equipment. They open up the system and then  
10 they take all sediment out of the chamber  
11 and everything else and clean it and then,  
12 you know, close it back up. But it is not  
13 the sponge system where they have to pull  
14 out an actual filtering device, and change  
15 it over and then dispose of that  
16 contaminated sponge.

17 MR. BERGEY: Actually, one of the first  
18 initial phases of this capitol program was  
19 installing a drain below the grate filters  
20 and we found that -- essentially what the  
21 Water Authority found is that they do not  
22 work up to expectations just because the  
23 main demand on them is so high, that flow --  
24 once you start installing large numbers to  
25 these, it becomes a main headache. Where as

2 this, this needs to be maintained. The  
3 maintenance intervals varies on it but six  
4 months to a year and-a-half depending on  
5 flow and the debris load and sediment load  
6 that these -- but we're also tracking that  
7 information.

8 We have GIS map and database set up to  
9 track the current installations, and then  
10 once these are installed, they will be added  
11 to that database -- you know, where we can  
12 kind of see, "Ok, it needed to me maintained  
13 after six months after eight months and  
14 there was this much debris in it." You  
15 know, that kind of information.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: And what is going to  
17 happen with your maintenance program and the  
18 budget situation?

19 MR. BERGEY: The maintenance program is  
20 pretty much budgeted independently. Like  
21 Mr. Bagg referenced, we all ready purchased  
22 the equipment. As long as the equipment  
23 remains functional, we will be fine as far  
24 as maintenance.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: What about the personnel

2 that goes around cleaning these systems out?

3 MR. BERGEY: So, meaning, God for bid  
4 there is no layoffs -- assuming the staff  
5 remains intact, we should be okay. It only  
6 takes, I believe, two individuals to run the  
7 machine so --

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: That is all you have for  
9 the entire County?

10 MR. BERGEY: Oh, no, for each machine  
11 there is three machines. One for each  
12 maintenance zone.

13 MR. CHAIRMAN: Do you see that as an  
14 issue, Jim?

15 MR. BAGG: No, I -- put it this way, if  
16 they put these systems in at the end,  
17 they're going to add capabilities which will  
18 improve the situation that actually, if we  
19 get to the point where we have budgetary  
20 problems and they have to lay people off, I  
21 think there is a big problem all the way  
22 around and it is just not for the  
23 maintenance of these systems. It is going  
24 to be the maintenance for the road and  
25 everything around it.

2 MR. BERGEY: Right, the very worst that  
3 could happen with these is if they start  
4 getting too full -- up to their storage  
5 capacity, they go into bypass mode. So they  
6 will, basically, be bypassing water -- it  
7 wont cause a flooding situation.

8 MR. KAUFMAN: Larry, also, given the  
9 fact that these are essentially point source  
10 discharges -- each of the sites that we're  
11 looking at and putting in something over  
12 there, even if it has a reduced maintenance  
13 cycle. If you have seen the pictures that  
14 we were given, I mean, these are just  
15 straight out point discharge sources. We  
16 have to do something.

17 MR. BERGEY: And if better technology  
18 comes along down the road, we can always go  
19 back and retrofit these somehow -- if we  
20 have to try and improve them even further.

21 MR. KAUFMAN: First off, I would like  
22 to compliment you on whoever put this packet  
23 together. These pictures really, really,  
24 really, help. You can see what is going on.  
25 The presentations normally are very, very

1 good. I don't have a problem with them.

2 This one was just very, very -- much better.

3 MR. BERGEY: Thank you, sir.

4 MR. KAUFMAN: Question on it.

5 Essential you're going to be putting these  
6 vortex systems at the end of an interceptor  
7 system plus as individual pre-standing  
8 structures at the point source of discharge.

9 MR. BERGEY: Right.

10 MR. KAUFMAN: That is essentially the  
11 plan as I understand it.

12 MR. BERGEY: Correct.

13 MR. KAUFMAN: How much of the  
14 pollutants do you think that you will be  
15 able to, basically, catch assuming these  
16 systems are working on a percentage basis?  
17 Do you think 50 percent, 70 percent?

18 MR. BERGEY: It varies based on the  
19 flow rate and what pollutant you're  
20 targeting. Really these systems, honestly,  
21 are not great at targeting dissolved  
22 pollutants. So pollutants in the water  
23 column itself, but anything that is absorbed  
24 to the sediment particles, it is very good  
25

1 at settling that out. So, given a typical  
2 flow rate which is about 1.3 inch of rain  
3 over the water shed area -- these can handle  
4 around 80 percent of the total suspended  
5 solids, and pretty much all the flow will  
6 stay the same and it will capture that.  
7

8 MR. KAUFMAN: I also noticed that there  
9 was some replacements of some of the catch  
10 basins in there so that may be able to  
11 handle some of the pollutants assuming they  
12 settle out?

13 MR. BERGEY: Yes, if we put a sump on  
14 the bottom of the catch basins, it will act  
15 as a low retreatment so the flow won't be as  
16 high to the treatment system.

17 MR. MACHTAY: Just one comment, yes,  
18 this was a impressive package you put  
19 together but not everything was labeled.  
20 Attachment 7, it was put in there without a  
21 label.

22 MR. BERGEY: Yes, I realized that after  
23 the fact, yes.

24 MR. MACHTAY: I was calling up and  
25 accusing people of all sorts of things, but

2 it turned out that it was really in there.

3 MR. BERGEY: I will take the blame for  
4 that. I apologize.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: Any there any other  
6 questions?

7 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

8 I have one trivial technical question.  
9 Looking at one of the drawings, there was a  
10 notation of fifteen, and then next to it  
11 there was like the foot symbol -- you know,  
12 1 slash. Except there were three. Is that  
13 now a symbol -- an excepted symbol for cubic  
14 feet?

15 MR. BERGEY: Not to my knowledge. It  
16 was probably a typo.

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: I was just wondering if  
18 I had missed something.

19 MR. KAUFMAN: You are seeing things,  
20 Mr. Chairman.

21 MR. MACHTAY: There is a typo on the  
22 first page on two of these letters -- her  
23 title.

24 MR. BERGEY: Maybe you should come  
25 review some plans for us.

MR. CHAIRMAN: This has been dropped on us, Jim.

MR. BAGG: If you could explain that. This is actually, Rich, in reviewing it Attachment Number 7, was a letter to the National Heritage Program asking if there are any rare endangered species on the site, and I kind of thought that normally applicants send letters to them and this is their response. They said they did not find any rare endangered species, so this really completes Attachment Number 7, which I was amazed.

MR. MACHTAY: I must say, you know, as someone who has worked in the environmental field for 30 years not finding anything rare or unusual in an aquatic environment is --

MR. KAUFMAN: Rare and unusual?

MR. MACHTAY: (Continuing) -- rare and unusual. I would suspect that probably something is hidden there someplace, but I don't think --

MR. KAUFMAN: These areas have been sub-butchered.

2 MR. BERGEY: There are a few locations  
3 where we come close -- we're very close to  
4 areas that they have identified as sensitive  
5 habitats, but as long as we stay inside our  
6 right-of-way, we should be fine.

7 MR. BAGG: An interesting point to  
8 point -- to make is that when you talk about  
9 rare and endangered species, most of the  
10 species are rare and endangered because they  
11 only occupy a niche in the successional  
12 evolution of a site, and very often they  
13 become out competed by other species that  
14 are moving in and in the next stages of  
15 succession.

16 MR. MACHTAY: The other thing is rare  
17 and endangered here is not rare and  
18 endangered someplace else. If you go down  
19 south, salamanders are -- it is live bait  
20 and here, it is a subject to stop any  
21 project that comes along.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay, so essentially,  
23 these all say that there are no rare and  
24 endangered species at these various  
25 locations; is that correct?

2 MR. BERGEY: That is correct.

3 MR. CHAIRMAN: All right. Couldn't the  
4 DEC have given us this before?

5 MR. BERGEY: I think we actually  
6 received that the day after we submitted the  
7 EAF. The timing was --

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: All right, do we have a  
9 motion?

10 MR. KAUFMAN: I will make a motion that  
11 this is an Unlisted Negative Declaration.

12 MR. MACHTAY: Second.

13 MR. CHAIRMAN: We have a motion and a  
14 second. Any further discussion?

15 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: All in favor?

17 THE COUNCIL: Aye.

18 MR. CHAIRMAN: All opposed?

19 (WHEREUPON there was no response.)

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Motion carries. Thank  
21 you very much.

22 (WHEREUPON, the Council voted.)

23 MR. CHAIRMAN: Has everybody sorted  
24 through their stuff and got their next  
25 project? These are Recommended Unlisted

2 Actions, Proposed Acquisition of Open Space  
3 Preservation known as the Clark's Beach --  
4 Village of Greenport Property in the Town of  
5 Southold.

6 **Lauretta?**

7 MS. FISCHER: Good morning. I am  
8 Lauretta Fischer, Principal Environmental  
9 Analyst, Department of Planning.

10 Before you today is the Clark Beach  
11 Acquisition. The County is looking to  
12 acquire 6.12 acres of a 15.3 acre parcel  
13 owned by the Village of Greenport. We're  
14 taking the eastern most triangular portion  
15 of the property which is adjacent to inlet  
16 Pond County Park.

17 The property, in whole, actually is  
18 owned by the Village of Greenport. Also  
19 contains a sewage outflow pipe of which we  
20 are not acquiring. Also, the other western  
21 portion of it, is being considered by the  
22 Town of Southold for acquisition.

23 At this point in time they have not  
24 come to an agreement as far as acquisition  
25 between the Town and the Village. So this

is what is set up as a separate acquisition. One part being the County acquisition adjacent to the County park to the east, and a separate acquisition of the western portion of it with the Town of Southold.

We are, again, acquiring 6.12 acres. There are trails connecting our property to the east with this property. Actually, you can see it on the aerial near the northern portion of the property. There are some dirt roads that preexist there, and there is a trail that leads into the County property, so access through the property will be from our existing holding to the east.

The easement for the sewage treatment pipe actually follows a linear line just immediately to the west of the County proposed acquisition. It follows from North Road all the way to the sound, and that will stay in Village ownership without any kind of acquisition as part of that area.

There is a little cut out on the map, and that is part of the operation of the pipe, and so that will not be part of the

1 acquisition itself. There is a structure on  
2 it for maintenance of the pipe and so that  
3 was cut out and will not be acquired as part  
4 of our acquisition. It is under the new  
5 Drinking Water Protection Program for open  
6 space preservation.  
7

8 MR. KAUFMAN: **Lauretta**, question? The  
9 outflow pipe, how far out does it go? I  
10 hope it doesn't just end at the beach.

11 MS. FISCHER: I don't know the  
12 specifics of it. My understanding is it is  
13 -- there is length out there as far as my  
14 understanding of it is. I don't know how  
15 far out it is.

16 MR. KAUFMAN: Even though it is treated  
17 water, it is not going to necessarily impact  
18 the parcel itself that the County is  
19 proposing purchasing?

20 MS. FISCHER: No, that has been there  
21 for many years -- that pipe. So I don't  
22 think it has adversely effected the local  
23 habitat in that area, to my knowledge.

24 MR. KAUFMAN: One other question on it  
25 just because I am trying -- worrying myself

2 with the map -- the lines don't make any  
3 sense to me. Immediately to the east of the  
4 parcel, there is land bordered by green  
5 lines which appears to be Suffolk County  
6 lines, and then there is a large pond or  
7 lake or whatever seems to be part of that  
8 parcel; is that County owned right now?

9 MS. FISCHER: Yes, and there is a small  
10 piece of land that is owned by the Town of  
11 Southold in purple also there. (Indicating)  
12 but that whole parcel is County owned, and  
13 that Inlet Pond County park.

14 MR. RUSSO: One other question,  
15 **Lauretta?** Just out of curiosity -- general  
16 information -- is it unusual for the County  
17 to be purchasing land open space from  
18 another municipality?

19 MS. FISCHER: Yes, it is.

20 MR. RUSSO: I thought it was kind of  
21 odd, and I was just wondering what the  
22 reasoning was behind it?

23 MS. FISCHER: Well, according to the  
24 Village of Greenport their interest is  
25 financial. They want to exercise this

1  
2 property for balancing their budget. They  
3 had budgetary problems. This property  
4 itself is actually outside the Incorporated  
5 Village boundaries but, obviously, was  
6 bought many, many years ago for the sewage  
7 pipe, and has been informally used over the  
8 years for scuba diving activities and alike.  
9 Right now, there is chain linked fence at  
10 the entrance so access has been limited over  
11 the last few years, but this was proposed by  
12 the Village.

13 There's pros and cons with this. It is  
14 adjacent to our county holdings which is a  
15 plus. We don't like to acquire property  
16 necessarily from another municipality in  
17 general because it opens up that issue of  
18 "Well, anyone -- any municipality can come  
19 to the County and say, "Well, I cannot  
20 afford it anymore." What do we do? So it  
21 opens up those types of issues. But, in  
22 general, I feel we were supportive of it  
23 because of our interest adjacent to it.  
24 Their feeling that has been expressed to the  
25 County is that they would be selling this

2 privately if the County and or Village -- I  
3 mean, and or Town of Southold was not going  
4 to acquire this.

5 MR. RUSSO: But the Town of Southold  
6 has expressed interest in the solid red  
7 areas?

8 MS. FISCHER: They have made offers. I  
9 don't think they have been accepted. I  
10 don't know anymore then that at this point.  
11 Obviously, that showed an interest but that  
12 negotiation is between the Town and the  
13 Village.

14 MR. MACHTAY: It seems that this parcel  
15 of land is landlocked for all intentional  
16 purposes especially --

17 MS. FISCHER: It will be --

18 MR. MACHTAY: (Continuing) --  
19 especially with the pipe coming down -- I  
20 guess the west side?

21 MS. FISCHER: Correct.

22 MR. MACHTAY: What would they sell it  
23 for? For private --

24 MS. FISCHER: The property itself  
25 includes the solid red area and the outlined

2 red area. The property is being subdivided.

3 MR. MACHTAY: But the County is not  
4 buying the solid red area?

5 MS. FISCHER: No, the Town -- we're in  
6 negotiation with the Town and then --

7 MR. MACHTAY: So just excise the  
8 triangular parcel it sort of --

9 MR. BAGG: We own the green area, Rich.  
10 This all County Park next to it?

11 MR. MACHTAY: Yes, but if a private  
12 party came and bought the triangular parcel,  
13 it is landlocked. They cannot do anything  
14 with it.

15 MR. BAGG: No, we're only buying a  
16 portion of the site. The whole site is  
17 adjacent to the road up here. (Indicating.)

18 MR. MACHTAY: I understand that, but if  
19 that is public property -- if the solid  
20 portion is public property, and then you  
21 have the County property on the other side,  
22 the triangular portion is landlocked; a  
23 private party cannot get to it.

24 MR. KAUFMAN: Yes, but you're talking  
25 about in terms of how the compensation is

1 set up. I understand the zoning aspect, but  
2 if you're looking at it in terms of  
3 subdivision, et cetera, the triangular  
4 portion that the County is buying is  
5 essentially being added over here. So, yes,  
6 maybe we can get a deal. (Indicating.)  
7

8 MR. MACHTAY: I understand that, but if  
9 they wanted to sell that parcel of land to a  
10 private party, the private party has hardly  
11 anything they could do with it.

12 MR. KAUFMAN: And it would be a much  
13 lower purchase price. Unfortunately, there  
14 is municipal that is the issue. I think we  
15 should leave that to the greater God for the  
16 appraisal department.

17 MR. MACHTAY: Well, it is up to the  
18 Legislature to decide what they want to do.

19 MS. FISCHER: Right.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Any other comments?

21 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Anyone to make a motion?

23 MR. KAUFMAN: Motion Unlisted Negative  
24 Declaration.

25 MS. GROWNEY: Second.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: We have a second.

3 Any further discussions?

4 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: All in favor?

6 THE COUNCIL: Aye.

7 (WHEREUPON, the Council voted.)

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: Are we being held  
9 hostage price wise by threats to the Village  
10 to sell it privately?

11 MS. FISCHER: Um --

12 MR. KAUFMAN: Don't answer that,  
13 I **Lauretta**, take the fifth.

14 MS. FISCHER: I am going to defer. I  
15 can't speak officially to that.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: All right, moving onto  
17 the next piece that is the Proposed  
18 Acquisition For Open Space Preservation.  
19 This time it is the Wickham Creek, Dawson  
20 and Hollow Property in the Town of Southold.

21 MS. FISCHER: This is a property of  
22 primary titled wetland along Wickham Creek  
23 in the Town of Southold. It is a 3.2 acre  
24 lot in an area that we hold other properties  
25 to the west on Wickham Farm. We own the

1 farm land development right to those  
2 properties outlined in green. (Indicating)  
3 so there is various interest going on here.  
4 It is a very unique area with regards to  
5 extensive farming activities going on here,  
6 and then we have a creek that has  
7 environmental conditions including extensive  
8 title wetlands in there.  
9

10 You can look at the map with regard to  
11 the diagonal black lines. Those are other  
12 parcels, in addition, to this parcel that  
13 we're looking to acquire to protect this  
14 watershed of Wickham creek. This would be  
15 our first acquisition in the area. We're  
16 buying this under the new drinking water for  
17 freshwater and title wetland protection for  
18 past recreation use.

19 MR. CHAIRPERSON: We maintain Wickham  
20 Creek by dredging -- the County, I mean.

21 MS. FISCHER: The County? I don't know  
22 for sure.

23 MR. KAUFMAN: There is a dredge scar  
24 there. (Indicating.)

25 MS. FISCHER: There is a dredge scar

1 there. There are other residential homes  
2 interior, and there is a marina that is  
3 situated south of there, so I don't know if  
4 it is either the County dredging operation  
5 or private, but it is dredged.  
6

7 MR. CHAIRMAN: Has this property every  
8 been used for dredge disposal?

9 MS. FISCHER: This site?

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: Yes.

11 MS FISCHER: Not to my knowledge. It  
12 hasn't shown with dredge spoil on the title  
13 wetland map. It might be that --

14 MR. MACHTAY: I am curious. Is this  
15 residentially zoned?

16 MS. FISCHER: I believe so, yes.

17 MR. MACHTAY: Could they build houses  
18 on this?

19 MS. FISCHER: There is some up land  
20 portion of this. I would have to go back  
21 and look at the -- let me see --

22 MR. MACHTAY: Because I notice that  
23 we're not taking anything offered for the  
24 purpose of workforce housing, and I guess it  
25 must be under developed or developable in

some fashion that it doesn't yield.

MS. FISHER: Right, exactly. I believe it would be very difficult to develop it. I feel under existing conditions with existing zoning, it would not be developable but variances, of course, can always be applied and properties like these, ultimately, can be developed if the owner is so inclined.

MR. KAUFMAN: Question? I know we have be given Master Lists One and Two. I have never seen three and four; are those recent?

MS. FISCHER: No, three was immediately after two and included just a few lots in including the North Fork Preserve, and the Boys and Girls Harbor out in East Hampton. Number 4, was primarily presented by Legislator Romaine, and for the North Fork property, we worked with Legislator Romaine to include other partials to improve the protection of certain habitats that were initially identified by him, so it was a working cooperative working effort.

MR. KAUFMAN: One other thing is, if you look at the points of land above the

1 Cutchogue Harbor, it looks like that may be  
2 a spoil disposal area. It is on the Master  
3 List. It is not part of the purchase or  
4 anything like that, but you can see a dredge  
5 scar in there and, again, it looks as there  
6 is a swimming to the north of there. I  
7 don't they're putting spoil over there. It  
8 looks like it is to the south -- looks up  
9 land and looks like it is filled marshes.  
10 It is interesting, if nothing else.

11  
12 MR. CHAIRMAN: Do we have a motion?

13 MR. KAUFMAN: Unlisted negative  
14 declaration.

15 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second.

16 MR. RUSSO: Second.

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: Any further discussions?

18 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

19 MR. CHAIRMAN: All in favor?

20 THE COUNCIL: Aye.

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: All opposed?

22 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

23 MR. CHAIRMAN: Motions carries.

24 MS. FISCHER: Thank you.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Purposed Storm water

2 Remediation to County Road 80, Montauk  
3 Highway at Oceanview.

4 MR. DAWSON: Good morning. My name is  
5 Jeff Dawson. I am a senior Civil Engineer  
6 With the Department of Public Works of  
7 Suffolk County, and I am here to introduce  
8 our consultant, GRC Gedeon Consulting  
9 Engineering.

10 We have been progressing a project on  
11 Montauk Highway just east of Shinnecock  
12 Canal for, approximately, the last ten years  
13 and we're finally in the home stretch, and  
14 are now ready to sprint towards the finish  
15 line.

16 So where we're at right now is the  
17 design is, approximately, 75 percent  
18 complete, and we're before you guys today to  
19 get the SEQRA approval after which we intend  
20 on going to DEC for their approval. DEC did  
21 provide comment on a smaller scale project  
22 in the same area, however, we found an  
23 opportunity to obtain additional funding so  
24 we decided to increase the scope and  
25 effectiveness of the project which is

1  
2 basically geared towards improving the water  
3 quality of the Shinnecock Bay by installing  
4 a drainage system and some storm water  
5 treatment structure. So, without further  
6 ado, I would like introduce Rudy Gedeon of  
7 Gedeon Engineer Consulting.

8 MR. GEDEON: Good morning. My name is  
9 Rudy Gedeon from Gedeon GRC Consulting.

10 Again, thank you for allowing me to  
11 make the presentation today. The project is  
12 actually along Montauk Highway from  
13 Maidstone Lane to West Hillover Street. It  
14 is along County Road 80, which is a full  
15 lane. You have one lane in each direction  
16 and you have lined shoulders on both sides.

17 Now, there is some significant drainage  
18 problems along that segment of County Road  
19 80. Basically, there is no inlet basin  
20 catching water, so we have recurring  
21 flooding problems along the segment. In  
22 addition to this, we basically have no water  
23 quality system before we discharge into the  
24 Shinnecock Bay. There are two outfalls,  
25 basically, two systems. One to the west

1 picks up water basically to the east of  
2 Oceanview and discharges water through a 50  
3 inch pipe into the bay. There is a system  
4 to the west actually that has another  
5 outfall. They're twin pipes -- two 12 inch  
6 pipes that discharge water into the bay.  
7

8 When you look at the photographs, this  
9 is actually the west outfall and the  
10 bulkhead -- both outfalls actually go  
11 through a private property to drainage  
12 easement. Now, we're looking at the west  
13 outfall and we're looking at the existing  
14 bulkhead. The photograph is actually  
15 showing the pipe that is, I would say, 90  
16 percent buried and it happens -- most of  
17 them -- any time that Suffolk County will go  
18 out there and drain it, basically, it is in  
19 high tide which brings -- blocks the outfall  
20 to make -- basically, rendering the existing  
21 system nonfunctional.

22 On the east side, we have a twin pipe  
23 system. Again, they are always 80 to 90  
24 percent buried. So the objective of the  
25 project, basically, is two-fold. One is to

1  
2 mitigate the flooding, and the second one is  
3 also to provide water quality before we  
4 discharge into the bay.

5 So we came up with a system -- a closed  
6 drainage system where we provide a number of  
7 basins -- leeching basins throughout the  
8 project limits on each side of the shoulder  
9 and then create a conveyance system where we  
10 discharge into the bay at the same location,  
11 but using new pipes. One thing that we are  
12 proposing is to raise the input of the  
13 outlet so that in high tide, we don't flood  
14 the system.

15 Before we discharge into the bay, we  
16 are proposing to install the vortex system  
17 similar to what the other gentleman  
18 mentioned before. Suffolk County has been  
19 using this system from a maintenance  
20 standpoint and from a performance  
21 standpoint, and Suffolk County -- DPW is  
22 actually happy with this system.

23 One thing, I think, was a discussion in  
24 terms of clogging. The vortex system has  
25 four chambers and, I think, one of the

1 beauty of the vortex system is that the  
2 first chamber which is, basically, the great  
3 chamber -- the soul chamber allows sediments  
4 to settle and the third chamber which is the  
5 flow control chamber rejuvenates the flow to  
6 allow the suspended sediment not to reflood  
7 again. I think that is the beauty of the  
8 vortex system. It has been used -- they go  
9 up to 89 percent in terms of performance, in  
10 terms of production of sediment.  
11

12 There are some other issues along the  
13 project, in addition, to drainage. Some  
14 pavement items that we are actually  
15 proposing resurfacing the waterway and  
16 repairing some of the existing concrete  
17 pavement at localized areas. As far as  
18 impact, there is no widening. We are not  
19 removing existing trees. We're providing  
20 water quality and at the same time, we are  
21 not increasing the watershed. In a nut  
22 shell, that is what we're proposing.

23 MR. KAUFMAN: Question for you, sir? I  
24 was looking at the water table in the area  
25 and I was also looking at the project design

1 in terms of where these things would go.

2 The first thing is it looks like the vortex  
3 is sometimes at the bottom of them -- are  
4 sitting below the water table, and I know  
5 the water table probably moves up and down  
6 in that area under the influence of the high  
7 tide. Are we going to have any backing up  
8 occurring because of that?

9  
10 MR. GEDEON: One thing that we actually  
11 -- we have different numbers in terms of the  
12 high water tide level, and that is one thing  
13 we're looking at. When we raise it, we're  
14 looking to provide tide flood gates that  
15 allows water to come out and not go back and  
16 that is something that we're looking at and  
17 discussing with Suffolk County right now.  
18 But the idea is not to allow backing up into  
19 the system and preventing high pressure --  
20 preventing the water from discharging.

21 MR. KAUFMAN: Essentially, you would be  
22 dealing with a hyperstatic pressure in that  
23 situation?

24 MR. GEDEON: Yes.

25 MR. KAUFMANN: In the areas with the

1  
2 vortex where you're not going to be using  
3 tide gates, are any of the vortex systems,  
4 at the bottom of them, going to be sitting  
5 inside the water table?

6 MR. GEDEON: Yes, the one we are using,  
7 basically, we have high -- the one thing  
8 with this system is that when you look at  
9 County Road 80, it is basically at the  
10 bottom of a hill. So we have a very high --  
11 a very big watershed area. Now, we're using  
12 the biggest vortex system which is 60,000 --  
13 I think it is about 13 by 9, and it is about  
14 eight foot deep. So we're going into the  
15 water table, but since it is an enclosed  
16 chamber, there will be some de-watering  
17 doing construction but it will sit into --

18 MR. KAUFMANN: The final question I  
19 have is, it looks as if you were putting --  
20 reconstructing on both sides of the road,  
21 and I was looking at the topography of the  
22 area. Would it make -- I am curious why you  
23 have it on both sides? If I were designing  
24 the project, I would have had most  
25 everything on the north side of the road to

1 try and stay a little bit away from the --  
2 from the saltwater intrusion. You're only  
3 talking about 30 feet or something like  
4 that.  
5

6 MR. GEDEON: Right, a couple of items.  
7 We looked at similar locations with Suffolk  
8 County Public Works. At one time we wanted  
9 to use twin pipes but, again, in terms of  
10 costing and terms of construction of the  
11 shoulder, it is an expensive venture.

12 The second thing is that we have a high  
13 pressure water gap on the north side of the  
14 shoulder which makes it difficult. They  
15 made a smaller water -- gas main on the  
16 south shore. One of biggest items for us is  
17 that it is a crowded -- it is a crowded  
18 roadway. What happens is that when water  
19 comes at sheet flow, it goes into the  
20 properties on the south side because we  
21 can't catch it. So what we're proposing to  
22 do is by having catch basins on the south  
23 shore and running the pipe, is to come up  
24 with a type of shoulder to allow -- to  
25 direct the flow into the catch basin because

2 if not, it goes straight into the property  
3 down there.

4 MR. KAUFMANN: Basically, you're saying  
5 you have a very, very crowded area in there;  
6 not too much to work with?

7 MR. GEDEON: Yes.

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: Are you going to rebuild  
9 the bulkhead?

10 MR. GEDEON: Well, the bulkhead --  
11 there will be some work done. For instance,  
12 once we remove this pipe, we're debating  
13 whether we are going to in-fill it or remove  
14 it and backfill it. Definitely there is  
15 going to be some construction done here, but  
16 as far as rebuilding the entire bulkhead,  
17 no. We would basically provide a space to  
18 allow the pipe to come out and seal it. But  
19 there won't be a full reconstruction of the  
20 bulkhead. It will be partial as required.

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: The bulkhead is in  
22 private ownership?

23 MR. GEDEON: It is, yes. Actually both  
24 discharges, basically, are the outfalls into  
25 private property and then you have easement

-- Suffolk County and DPW have easement with the owners.

MR. CHAIRMAN: So you will replace the type of material in time?

MR. GEDEON: In time, yes.

MR. CHAIRMAN: Any questions?

MS. SPENCER: Just an observation. There is an article in this mornings Newsday that all of this may be moot in the near future.

MR. KAUFMAN: Why?

MS. SPENCER: We're going to flood out.

MR. KAUFMANN: We're all going to flood out. Well, for the next thirty years, I think we should try and -- well, if they're all wrong, which they usually are. They're probably economist -- the next five years.

Motion --

MS RUSSO: I had a quick question, Rudy. How many new basins do you propose to install? How many exist now? Just curious.

MR. GEDEON: We're talking about 20 maybe 25 to 30 new. We have only, I would say, four right now and that is only --

2 water keeps flowing -- sheet flow and is not  
3 picked up and that's why sometimes we have  
4 flooding in the area.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: Did you make the motion  
6 --

7 MR. KAUFMAN: Motion for an Unlisted  
8 Action Negative Declaration.

9 MS. RUSSO: I second that.

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay, there is a motion  
11 and there is a second. Any further  
12 discussions, comments?

13 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

14 MR. CHAIRMAN: All in favor?

15 THE COUNCIL: Aye.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: All opposed?

17 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

18 MR. CHAIRMAN: Motion carries.

19 Thank you.

20 MR. KAUFMAN: You read Newsday?

21 MS. SPENCER: Yes.

22 MR. KAUFMAN: Obviously, it is just a  
23 fountain of scientific knowledge and it  
24 knows everything and it will -- always will  
25 be perfect, but they said there are new sea

level rising issues coming up or something?

I have not read Newsday. I was reading my  
CEQ packet a second time.

MS. RUSSO: It is an article regarding  
the predictions of sea level rising issues  
and several different scenarios and in how  
many years.

MS. SPENCER: Right, how high and how  
many years.

MS. RUSSO: And they had a conference  
something like a week ago and they didn't  
have much participation but the DEC is  
planning for it and discussing it.

MS. SPENCER: I have a question. We  
were talking about the proposed storm drain  
pollution on various county roads, and there  
was a question of rare and endangered  
species. I would just like to point out  
that the flying foxes of Australia are rare,  
and if they're in your home, they're  
endangered. Just for the record.

(WHEREUPON, there was laughter.)

MR. KAUFMAN: Mary Ann, if I see an  
Australian flying fox, I am definitely

1 taking it down.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: Historic services?

3 MR. MARTIN: Just a brief update. The  
4 Babylon Town Historical Society has signed  
5 their contract with the Van Bourgondien  
6 House. So, hopefully, they will be moving  
7 in there soon. We do have a meeting with  
8 the Housing Committee. I don't know if Mary  
9 Ann mentioned this. It is tomorrow at ten  
10 in o'clock which we will be reviewing more  
11 of our residential sites for possible  
12 adjustments of the rents so we can get them  
13 all occupied. As I reported before, working  
14 out very well.

15 Also, the Commission and I will be  
16 giving a presentation to the Parks Committee  
17 next Wednesday on the building survey that  
18 we handed out at the last meeting. They  
19 have some questions on that. So we will  
20 both be attending that to give a brief  
21 presentation and to answer any of their  
22 questions. That is all I have.

23 MR. CHAIRMAN: Several months ago, we  
24 discussed the possibility of holding a CEQ  
25

2 meeting at one of the historical sites --  
3 have you given any thought to that?

4 MR. MARTIN: Yes, at the time I thought  
5 Scully House might be a good site. If  
6 anyone can offer us any ideas that are  
7 environmental centers for the County. We're  
8 finishing up, at this point, Phase 2 of the  
9 renovation of the building, and we might be  
10 interested in doing that.

11 MS. SPENCER: Or Isaac Mills?

12 MR. MARTIN: Or Isaac Mills is a  
13 possibility. That is in St. James.

14 MS. RUSSO: Earl Hubbard?

15 MR. MARTIN: Hubbard. I don't know,  
16 what, at this point -- what your interest  
17 would be in the sense of the historic site  
18 -- so your priority would be?

19 MR. CHAIRMAN: I don't have any  
20 particular priority. This has, in the past,  
21 been a very nice way for the Committee to  
22 become familiar with some of the sites that,  
23 in all likelihood, most of us haven't seen.

24 MR. MARTIN: Do you want us to discuss  
25 it further and get back to you?

1  
2 MS. SPENCER: I think you should talk  
3 to Mr. Chairman and the two of you should  
4 agree upon the site. I said Isaac Mills  
5 because that is the one that we will be  
6 coming forward to the CEQ at some point, and  
7 it is on the next register. It has been  
8 recently acquired County property, but I  
9 think it should be the two of you that  
10 should determine where we will meet. I like  
11 the idea of meeting in a historical  
12 location.

13 MR. KAUFMAN: By the way, I think you  
14 should add Blydenberg to that. It is  
15 relatively close in terms of staff time. It  
16 is also one of the few complexes that we  
17 have in the area that --

18 MS. SPENCER: And it was our very  
19 first.

20 MR. KAUFMAN: (Continuing) -- and ~~that~~ was  
21 our very first.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Considering the weather  
23 that I remember right after Deep Wells  
24 (Phonetic) purchased land -- excitedly took  
25 CEQ over there, and it is now the middle of

1 Winter and there was no heat -- middle of  
2 Winter in November and it was a different  
3 experience.  
4

5 MS. SPENCER: We won't do this before  
6 April.

7 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay.

8 Any other questions?

9 MR. KAUFMAN: One thing. This goes  
10 back maybe one month, possibly two. Richard  
11 raised a question as to the reconstruction  
12 that was going on, on Property 17, which is  
13 Carlton Avenue -- Central Islip High School,  
14 et cetera. You had raised the issue of  
15 bicycle paths, et cetera. Looking at the  
16 bikeway and trail ways map, and there is  
17 nothing marked on there. There is something  
18 on Joshua's Path, and Islip Avenue which is  
19 Route 111 and is about a half-a-mile to the  
20 west, but there is nothing on 17, so we make  
21 the correct decision that way.

22 MR. MACHTAY: The problem I wanted to  
23 point out was -- Rich made a good point as  
24 to -- it is in the planning code that a  
25 municipality, if they are considering any

1 project, has to consider the local master  
2 plan. Huntington now has passed a section  
3 of their master plan for the bikeways to  
4 acknowledge -- made a copy of it as well to  
5 New York State Planning, and I am trying to  
6 find out public bikeway plans in other  
7 municipalities.  
8

9 I would like to prepare a letter from  
10 the Chairman to DPW quoting the Planning Law  
11 and stating that there are bike plans -- you  
12 know, have been adopted and that the  
13 Department of Public Works should consider a  
14 bike alternative. As a part of their  
15 review, they don't have to necessarily go  
16 with it, but they have to consider their  
17 municipalities planning, and they should be  
18 altered to that so that when they come to  
19 CEQ, you're going to have questions.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Joy?

21 MS. SQUIRES: Thank you so much. I  
22 think that is excellent, and I think that  
23 evolves very nice from several of our  
24 somewhat impassioned discussions.

25 MR. BAGG: You make a good point. Now

1  
2 you got a bike plan, so take it to the  
3 planner.

4 MR. MACHTAY: I think, also, if -- you  
5 know, I use to keep one file cabinet in my  
6 office full of case law, and any time  
7 anything came up that I wasn't sure of, I  
8 would go through the case law and there was  
9 plenty of case law on what it means -- what  
10 does the word "environment" mean to man?  
11 Because the manmade environment is as  
12 important to man as the forest is to the  
13 trees and the trees are to birds and so on  
14 and so forth, and when DPW comes and says,  
15 "It is not the environment," because all  
16 we're doing is working on a road, it most  
17 certainly is the environment and effects the  
18 people that live adjacent to it and the  
19 surrounding area and in many different ways.  
20 If not drainage, then air quality, traffic,  
21 and so on and so forth. So, if you're going  
22 to change the manmade environment, that is  
23 environment also and that really -- I don't  
24 mean to put their feet to the fire every  
25 time they come here, but certainly it has to

be taken under consideration.

MR. KAUFMANN: You actually open a very old wound. This Commission, figure 15 years ago, was asked to look at the reconstruction of Vanderbilt Parkway from Dix Hills east and west and it was going to be very, very expensive. They considered the highway to be somewhat unsafe. They were going to start taking off the tops of hills and basically making the sidelines better and doing the taking of property. If you know the highway, it is actually a very, very picturesque highway especially in your town and I remember they arranged a bus trip for all of us. I was very, very unhappy -- nothing happened to the Commission -- I was very, very unhappy with the attitude that I was seeing from some of the engineers at that time. "It is a road, let us do what we want," and you know, fortunately, the project didn't go forward but it is something to consider teaching when we talk about reconstruction of the road. Sometimes a road may not just be a road.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: Wasn't it declared  
3 historic?

4 MR. KAUFMAN: Yes, it was but they  
5 didn't care.

6 MS. SQUIRES: In addition, Mike, that  
7 portion goes -- designates a path and has  
8 been worked on -- is being worked in.

9 MR. KAUFMANN: Well, this was 15 years  
10 ago --

11 MS. SQUIRES: Yes, I am talking about  
12 right now.

13 MR. CHAIRMAN: Are they destroying what  
14 we tried to protect 15 years ago?

15 MS. SQUIRES: No, they're identifying  
16 and mapping.

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: Any other comments?  
18 Joy, it is your turn.

19 MS. SQUIRES: I have something I am  
20 going to try, and maybe you're going to jump  
21 at me, but I am doing it on behalf of the  
22 Town.

23 This is a request, if you as the  
24 Commission of CEQ, might consider writing a  
25 letter of support of a project and this

1 comes via David and Margo Miles (Phonetic)  
2 -- that is the name. This is the scrap  
3 metal watershed project and we're trying to  
4 get a grant. It is a Crab Meadow Hydro  
5 Geological Study and it is a planning study  
6 to see if restoration should be considered.  
7 This is a large marshland and we have been  
8 concerned by the preservation of marshland.  
9 This is kind of a very simple letter that  
10 would support it to Senator Gilderbrandt.  
11

12 MR. CHAIRMAN: Well, I won't say no,  
13 but let me just mention that I would like to  
14 discuss it with Jim because, originally, I  
15 had worked with the Town of Huntington to  
16 develop a proposal in which I was going to  
17 work on it, and I want to make sure there is  
18 no conflict of interest because of that  
19 previous interaction.

20 MS. SQUIRE: Perhaps you would write a  
21 letter in support with your Stony Brook tile  
22 if you cannot do CEQ.

23 MR. KAUFMAN: Question? What kind of  
24 reconstruction are you talking about?

25 MS. SQUIRES: Oh, no, it is not

1 reconstruction.

2  
3 MR. KAUFMANN: What kind of water shed  
4 management?

5 MS. SQUIRE: It is a Hydro Geological  
6 Study of Crab Meadow because there have been  
7 issues there in terms of road issues. This  
8 is long term -- this has been something that  
9 we wanted to do for a long time but without  
10 a grant.

11 MR. KAUFMAN: You're looking more at  
12 the watershed as opposed to the marsh  
13 itself? Is that what you're talking about?

14 MS. SQUIRES: It is the whole marsh.

15 MR. CHAIRMAN: As I recall, there were  
16 times when people can't even get to their  
17 homes or out of their homes because of  
18 flooding and the whole --

19 MS. SQUIRES: But, of course, as he  
20 just pointed out, it will be a mood point in  
21 the wild.

22 Anyway, it is a study. It is not doing  
23 anything.

24 MR. KAUFMAN: I am, frankly, thinking  
25 about it in terms of what recently happened

1  
2 with the County Wide Management Program and  
3 the control. I know that there were issues  
4 with Crab Meadow that did come up. It is  
5 not high enough priority to support doing  
6 any kind of restoration efforts or anything  
7 like that. I am just curious.

8 MS. SQUIRES: This is just a grant for  
9 a study.

10 MR. MACHTAY: Who is supposed to do the  
11 study? Do you know or just --

12 MS. SQUIRES: Well, the study is all  
13 planned. We were trying to get a grant on  
14 it for maybe -- how long? Like 5 years.

15 MR. CHAIRMAN: At least.

16 MR. MACHTAY: No, I understand that,  
17 but who will conduct the study? Is the  
18 County going to do that on their own or are  
19 they --

20 MS. SQUIRES: David Bonte (Phonetic)  
21 from Stony Brook.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Any other business?

23 (WHEREUPON, there was no response.)

24 MR. CHAIRMAN: Do we have another  
25 motion -- well, let me say, Katherine, thank

you for attending. You came in very quietly  
but thank you for --

**MS. STARK:** There was a mistake in  
the building.

**MR. CHAIRMAN:** By mistake?

**MS. STARK:** Yes.

**MR. CHAIRMAN:** Your office does that  
regularly. We all do that, so don't feel  
badly and thank you for attending.

All right, do we have a motion to  
adjourn?

**MR. MACHTAY:** Motion.

**MR. CHAIRMAN:** Second?

**MS. RUSSO:** Second.

**MR. CHAIRMAN:** All in favor?

**THE COUNCIL:** Aye.

**MR. CHAIRMAN:** Motion carries.

(WHEREUPON, the Council voted.)

**MR. CHAIRMAN:** Another mission  
successfully carried out.

(WHEREUPON, this meeting was adjourned  
at 11:40 a.m.)

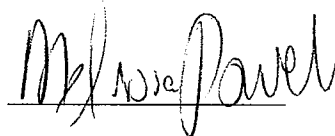
